<u>Caribbean Trumpet Tree</u> **Common name**: Caribbean Trumpet Tree, Silver Trumpet Tree, Yellow Tabebuia **Botanical name**: Tabebuia aurea **Family**: Bignonaceae; **Name in Tamil**: ?





Field Identification: Small tree, dry season-deciduous up to 12-15 m tall. Bark fissured, brown. Leaves palmately compound, with 3-5 leaflets, each leaflet 6–18 cm long, green with silvery scales. Flowers bright yellow, up to 6.5 cm diameter, in a loose panicle, entirely cover the tree in season. Fruit slender, 10 cm long capsule.
