Field identification: Mid-sized deciduous tree with characteristic long, drooping branchlets. Bark pale brown, with shallow vertical fissures. Leaves alternate 7-12 cm, long broad oval, margins wavy near apex. Flowers small, white in clusters. Fruit pale cherry with sticky pulp turning dark.

Location on campus: Rehabilitation Institute, near 751 flats.
