Dr. Mathew Joseph Retires



Dr. Mathew Joseph, popularly known as “J”, retired from Christian Medical College Vellore after serving the institution through the Department of Neurological Sciences on 4th May, 2026. After completing his schooling at St. Joseph’s Boys High School, Bengaluru, Dr. Joseph joined Christian Medical College as an undergraduate in 1979 and completed his MBBS in 1985. He joined M.Ch Neurosurgery (5 year course) and completed it in 1993. From 1993-1998, he worked in Department of Neurological Sciences in the Neurosurgery units. During this tenure he developed keen interest in Neurotrauma as the patients with brain injury, if managed optimally during the acute phase, can return to normal life in most instances.

Dr. Mammen Chandy, former Professor and Head of the Department of Clinical Haematology at CMC Vellore, led the team that established India's first sustained bone marrow transplantation programme in 1986 and performed the country's first bone marrow transplant for a patient with thalassemia. In recognition of his pioneering contributions to medicine, he was honoured with the Dr. B.C. Roy Award (2008) and the Padma Shri (2019).

He completed his study leave in University of Texas, Houston where he trained in Neurocritical care and Neurotrauma. On returning to Vellore, Dr. Joseph took up the challenge of establishing Neurocritical Care, at a time when the very term “Neurocritical Care” had not yet been coined and there were no established benchmarks or standards to follow in our country. Undeterred, he created his own benchmarks as the discipline evolved around him.

He has been instrumental in expanding the Neuro intensive care unit from a 12 bedded facility to the existing 50 bedded facility. Dr. J’s meticulous attention to detail, particularly regarding hand hygiene, has become legendary among generations of trainees and staff. His unwavering insistence on the rational use of antibiotics helped keep resistant organisms away from the Neuro ICU for remarkably long periods. His efforts over the past 25 years in developing Neurotrauma as a subspeciality in Neurosurgery in CMC has seen expansion of Neuro ICU, establishment of a multidisciplinary Brain Injury Clinic for follow up of these patients and development of protocols that are apt for our social and economic environment. His efforts have resulted in a major publication in a high impact Neurosurgery journal on the outcomes of traumatic brain injury and this has set standards for other institutes in India to follow. He also has developed and personally taken interest in maintaining a massive database of patients with traumatic brain injury (TBI), which he leaves to the institution as a legacy to be used for data mining and future research projects. Several of his innovations, including an indigenous and highly economical method of intracranial pressure (ICP) monitoring, have gone on to trend nationally. His work over the past quarter century has been recognised in India and abroad. He has served as President of the Neurotrauma Society of India from 2021-2023.

He has also been instrumental in developing the National TBI guidelines wherein he stresses the importance of having guidelines not merely based on available evidence but also in keeping with the practical feasibility of the same in a resource-constrained environment where the patient has to pay for the treatment. He strongly believes that Neurotrauma patients deserve the best care and always underscores the importance of how guidelines followed in the west cannot be adapted verbatim in Indian centres due to the sheer costs and resources involved. Through dedicated bedside teaching across all cadres of staff and students, he fostered a shared and universal language in the Neuro ICU, for communication regarding unconscious patients - the Glasgow Coma Scale (GCS) scoring. He was also instrumental in initiating Basic Life Support (BLS) training for staff and students at Christian Medical College Vellore. In addition, he remained actively involved in the Early Management of Trauma Course, designed by the Emergency Department from its inception to date. Apart from patient care, he was also part of the GAAT committee of the institution.

Though he appeared tough on the exterior within the ICU, he was a warm-hearted person who stood up for his colleagues in times of crisis or their needs, irrespective of their cadre. His wife, Dr. Gagandeep Kang, is an accomplished microbiologist and researcher and is the Director, Global Health (Enterics, Diagnostics, Genomics & Epidemiology program) at the Gates Foundation. His elder son Arjun Kang Joseph is a lawyer and younger son Tej Kang Joseph is an MBBS alumnus of CMC Vellore (Batch of 2015).

The Department of Neurological Sciences and our institution is grateful for his services to the institution and we wish him all the best in his future endeavours.

Institutional Epidemiology Workshop (E2- Protocol Development) For MD/MS Post Graduate Registrars



The Clinical Epidemiology Unit, CEU organised the Institutional Epidemiology Workshop - protocol development for the first year MD / MS / MOT / MPT post-graduates at the New Examination Hall between 1st and 3rd June 2026 (Batch III) on behalf of the principal's office. The workshop was attended by 85 MD/MS postgraduate registrars from all specialties. The workshop started with a word of prayer by Chaplain Ms.Saramma Kuruvilla, welcome address by Dr. Vignesh kumar Coordinator CEU, and an inspiring talk on "Why do research?" by Dr. Sathya Subramani, Sr. Professor, Department of Physiology.

Institutional Recommendation for Postgraduate Admissions 2026

Applications are invited from candidates interested in applying for Institutional Recommendation* for the broad specialty medical postgraduate courses indicated in the tabular column below. The application for institutional recommendation will be via an online application form from 17.06.2026 to 30.06.2026. The link for this application is <http://college.cmcvellore.edu.in/cmcpgs/>

- The application for institutional recommendation for PG courses 2026 session will close on 30/06/2026 at 5:00 pm. Please note the following:
- Candidates interested in being recommended for courses must contact the respective heads of department mentioned in the list below to discuss the same.
- Candidates who ask for recommendation from a department other than the broad specialty department, must also meet with the head of the broad specialty department.
- A candidate may apply for recommendation for sponsorship for a maximum of 3 courses.
- Candidates who fulfil the following criteria may apply:
 - o CMC graduates who have fulfilled their service obligation. Non-minority candidates will be eligible to apply under the Institutional Preference Category.
 - o Christian candidates from other institutions who have completed 2 years of work in a recognized mission hospital of which at least 6 months should have been in CMC. Christian candidates from other institutions applying for recommendation from a super specialty department and who have completed 2 years of work in a recognized mission hospital or in CMC, should have spent at least 6 months in the concerned super specialty department.
 - o Christian candidates from other institutions who have worked for a minimum of 6 months (out of the 2 years) in one of the hospitals managed by the CMC Missions Department (e.g. RMH, Washim, KMF, Kotagairi) can be recommended by the Missions Department; i.e. Institutional sponsorship for Missions, even if they have not worked in CMC.
- o Last date for completion of 2 years' service: 31/10/2026 (proof of completion of service must be provided with the application).
- The CMC application form for PG courses must be filled separately from the application for institutional recommendation/ sponsorship (<https://admissions.cmcvellore.ac.in/>).
- Once the online sponsorship application form is filled and supporting documents uploaded, candidates will receive a copy of the submitted form via email. A printout of this form must be submitted to the concerned recommending departments.
- Please note that candidates being recommended for a broad specialty course by a different Department, will need to submit a copy of the application to both the sponsoring Department and the concerned parent Broad Specialty Department for approval of the sponsorship.
